abridged told through his eyes starting with his crucifixion and flashing back through the story of the world and the reason he was sent to die on the cross it is a bible story exhaustively researched correct to the last detail not trivialised or altered in the least a chronologically accurate account from genesis to revelation with a riveting progression of interesting characters epic stories and events woven together so that the story of god and all of us reads like a sweeping historical novel and page turner you can't put down featuring an introduction by roma downey and a colour insert of exciting photos from tv mini series the bible

a witty and accessible look at scripture that explores what the bible meant before two millennia of mistranslations and misinterpretations publishers weekly starred review in this fascinating book acclaimed translator and biblical scholar dr joel m hoffman walks the reader through dozens of mistranslations misconceptions and other misunderstandings about the bible in forty short straightforward chapters he covers morality lifestyle theology and biblical imagery including the bible doesn't call homosexuality a sin and doesn't advocate for the one man one woman model of the family that has been dubbed biblical the bible's famous beat their swords into plowshares is matched by the militaristic beat your plowshares into swords the often cited new testament quotation god so loved the world is a mistranslation as are the titles son of man and son of god the ten commandments don't prohibit killing or coveting what does the bible say about violence about the rapture about keeping kosher about marriage and divorce hoffman provides answers to all of these and more succinctly explaining how so many pivotal biblical answers came to be misunderstood

in this study brian a verrett argues that 1 2 samuel contains a serpent motif by practicing biblical theology and literary criticism this motif derives from the serpent in genesis 3 and its function within the samuel narrative is to heighten the reader's anticipation in the coming messiah who is the son of david and the seed of the woman from genesis 3 15 this messiah will defeat the serpent and inaugurate his glorious reign over a renewed world when 1 2 samuel is read in this way one appreciates previously unnoticed features of the text understands aspects of the text that were formerly confusing and rightly sees that the whole of 1 2 samuel is a messianic document

finding a renewed christian story in a time of skepticism and doubt is christianity just a fairy tale for the infantile or worse a cruel fantasy the perpetrator of terrible harm and the cause of endless conflict at most one path among many

such questions reflect the skepticism of outsiders and the doubts of insiders some perennial some underscored by recent events and movements the answer to these objections isn't a louder faith to shout them down it's a humbler faith that points to a bigger god samuel wells shows the way through his generous respectful and earnest engagement with ten difficult questions about christianity in each case he portrays the traditional position and the skepticism of the modern age as two rival stories transcending both he then offers a revitalized christian story that better renders the radical courageous and vulnerable nature of authentic faith wells is unwaveringly honest about the failures of the institutional church and acknowledges many people's negative prior experiences of christianity making this a book for both christians and non christians who have found the stories of their lives disrupted and now seek a fulfilling and truthful story to live by
